Directions from OKC to Yonderland near Mulhall, Oklahoma (about 1 hour):

Drive north on Portland which becomes Hwy 74. At intersection of Hwy 74 and Hwy 33, turn East and go into Guthrie, where Hwy 33 will be Noble Street. Take Noble to the intersection of Wentz and Noble. (You'll see a CashSavers and a Baptist Church at corner.) Turn North on Wentz which will become Highway 77. (***)see below)

If driving from Edmond (about 30 minutes):

Take 2nd exit at Guthrie (Exit 157) off I-35. Turn left/West on Noble, drive about 1.8 miles to intersection of Noble and Wentz. Turn north on Wentz which will become Highway 77. (***)see below)

*****Edmond and OKC drivers continue with this route:**

Drive North on Hwy 77. After about 8.5 miles you will travel through a scenic area known as "wildcat curves." As you come out of the 1.5 mile long "curves," slow down as you drive uphill. You'll see a "Wiss Club Lambs" sign on the left. Turn left/West at this intersection, which is County Road 70. Follow the gravel road uphill 1/3 mile and turn right/North through the open double entry gate into Yonderland. Continue driving North on gravel road about 1/4 mile to facilities at top of hill.
